Session Levels

Track the liquidity each trading session leaves behind. Session Levels marks the **high and low of the sessions you care about** — Asia, London, New York — and shows you when a later session reaches back and sweeps them.

The idea: session liquidity

Every session carves out a range. Its high and low become the obvious liquidity for the sessions that follow — price reaches back to take them, then often turns. Session Levels keeps those highs and lows (and optional session boxes) on your chart and fades them once they're swept.

Session range

The build

Each session prints a high & low — the boundaries traders watch.

The sweep

The grab

A later session trades past a prior session's high/low — liquidity taken.

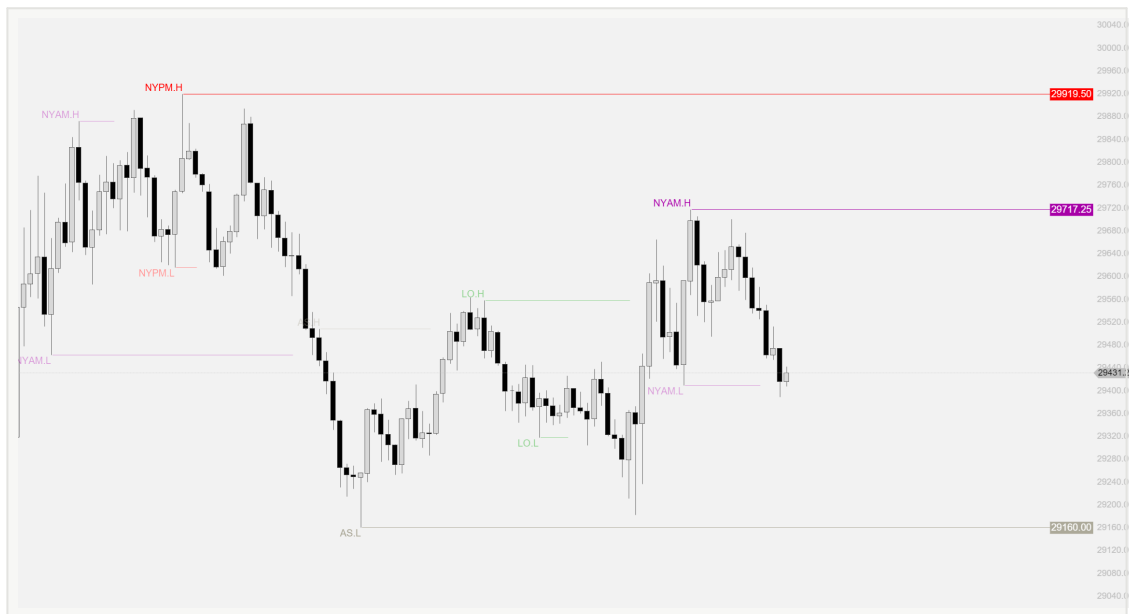
Session box

The zone

Optional shaded box marks the whole session's range for context.

What it draws on your chart

Session high & low lines	Two lines per session (e.g. AS.H / AS.L), coloured per session, labelled and extended right.
Up to 5 custom sessions	Asia, London, NY AM, NY Lunch, NY PM out of the box — each with its own name, time window and colour.
Sweep handling	When a level is taken it dims (adjustable) or hides, and the line freezes near the sweep.
Session boxes	Optional shaded rectangle over each session window (high to low).
Price tags	Exact price tags at the line end, kept out to the right so they never block the level.
Smart labels	When sessions' levels sit close together, their labels stack instead of overlapping — the chart stays clean, never cluttered.
History warning	If the chart hasn't loaded enough days for your "Days back" setting, an on-chart notice tells you.



Session Levels on a chart — Asia / London / New York highs & lows, taken levels faded.

Settings overview

Everything is optional and colour-adjustable. Here's what each group controls.

General	What it does
Days back to show	Only draw sessions from the last N calendar days.
Max scan bars	Safety cap on history scanned.
Line width / style	Thickness and full/dashed/dotted for the level lines.
Unbroken lines reach	Run unswept lines to the current bar or the price axis.
Sweep stop offset (bars)	Where a swept line freezes relative to the sweep bar.
Time offset (hours)	Shift candle time to align the session windows with your chart's clock.
Box	What it does
Show session box	Shade a rectangle over each session window.
Box opacity (%)	How strong the shading is.
Swept levels	What it does
Hide swept levels	Remove taken levels entirely — show only resting liquidity.
Dim swept / brightness	Fade taken levels and set how faint.
Price tag	What it does
Show / unswept only	Show the exact price tag, optionally only on untaken levels.
Colour mode / single colour / text	Tag background per session or one colour, plus text colour.

Labels	What it does
Show / position / font	Toggle labels, line start or end, set size.
Per session (1–5)	What it does
Enabled / Label	Turn the session on, set its short name (used in the label).
Window (HH:mm-HH:mm)	The session's time window.
Color	The session's colour.

Ways to use it

Session sweeps	Watch London reach back and take the Asia high or low — a classic liquidity grab before the real move.
Make them your sessions	Set any windows you trade (kill zones, opens) with your own names and colours.
Context with boxes	Turn on session boxes to see where price built and where it broke out.
Match your clock	Use the time offset once so the windows line up with the times you see on the chart.

Quick start

- 1 Add **Session Levels by Orderflow Edge** from the indicator list.
- 2 Set the time offset so the windows match your chart's clock.
- 3 Turn on the sessions you trade; tweak their windows and colours.
- 4 Pick dim or hide for swept levels, and you're set.

Know where liquidity rests.

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
